

CAROLIN KROPFF: 'FATA MORGANA'

(XVA GALLERY, DUBAI, UAE: 5 April – 5 May 2010) On 5th April, the debut solo show of German UAE-based artist Carolin Kropff will open at XVA Gallery. The exhibition, aptly entitled 'Fata Morgana', consists of a series of paintings, inspired by billboards created to promote Dubailand and the Bawadi theme hotels in Dubai. Both construction projects were to be located on the outskirts of Dubai, but were abolished prior to completion. The artist has dramatically recorded on large-scale canvases how these theatrical constructions appeared differently throughout the day, with changes of position and light. Kropff's work highlights the temporal landscape of Dubai, and in this case, its surreal qualities. Her work emphasizes the chameleon-like appearance of a city undergoing constant change and currently experiencing economic uncertainty.

CAROLIN KROPFF – ARTIST'S STATEMENT

Driving past these theatrical 3D constructions in a plain desert environment, I was enthralled by their chameleon-like appearance as the facades incessantly altered with the change of position, light and time. Under my mobile gaze, the simple industrialized illusions of the billboards faded beyond recognition, yet remained as monumental landmarks, as promises of fortune and pleasure of a future world. Both, the construction and deconstruction presented a surreal quality, an uneasy icon. In my work I follow that path to dissolve the visual world and meticulously put it back together with clusters of pigments, exploring the wide world of representation.

XVA GALLERY

From 2003, XVA has pioneered contemporary Middle Eastern art in Dubai. It is now one of the foremost contemporary art galleries in the Middle East. In 2008 and 2009 XVA participated at the Shanghai and Hong Kong Contemporary Art Fairs, the Asia Contemporary Art Fair in New York and the Dubai International Design Forum. XVA artists have recently exhibited in the 2009 Venice Biennale, Art Abu Dhabi 2009 and the 'Unveiled: New Art From the Middle East' exhibition at the Saatchi Gallery, London.
